TIPS FOR WRITING A GOOD BIO

Please send bios and photos to bios@k-9angelsrescue.org as soon as possible.

DO BE BRIEF

People have short attention spans. Don't delve too much into unnecessary details.

• DO STICK TO THE BIG THREE:

Personality, medical issues, and compatibility with other animals/kids are the only three things you need. There's no reason to write the animal's back-story unless it's *really* interesting. We don't want people to get bogged down in the dog's past. *His future starts now!* If it's a retired racing hound or police dog, mention it. If this particular dog fought off a mountain lion to protect her siblings, mention it.

In other words, only mention it if Disney would make a movie about it.

DO WRITE FROM THE DOG'S PERSPECTIVE

You don't have to do it every time, but it's an endearing format to use. People LOVE to put words into animals' mouths.

DO TURN NEGATIVES INTO POSITIVES

If Buddy isn't housetrained, don't say he pooped on the floor 3 times. Say Buddy is working on his house manners and is almost there!

DON'T DESCRIBE THE DOG'S APPEARANCE

There are several pictures on every bio, so describing the animal's fur color is unnecessary. The exception to this rule is writing something cute like "This yellow lab proves that blondes DO have more fun!"
